TASTING NOTES

Dark ruby color combines with a lively nose of bright red fruits, candied cherry, earthy tones, spice and a hint of cola. Inviting red cherry and strawberry notes balance with structured tannins and vibrant acidity to present an elegant harmony. The opulent mouth-feel leads to a languorous finish.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Vineyard: Split Rock
Appellation: Sonoma Coast
Harvest Date: 09/06/2008
Brix at Harvest: 26
Hand harvested, hand sorted and de-stemmed
Cold Soak: 5 days
Fermented in small bins with 3 punch-downs/day
Total skin contact: 12 days
Free run gravity-racked into barrels
Gently pressed and combined with free run
Aged 14 months in 100% French oak, 33% new
Final pH: 3.68
Total Acidity: 6.0 g/l
Final Alc. By Vol. 14%
Racked once prior to bottling
Production: 50 cases
