



STOMPING GIRL WINES

2012 BERESINI VINEYARD – CARNEROS – PINOT NOIR

Vineyard: Steve Beresini retired as a winemaker working alongside legendary Andre Tchelistcheff and planted his own vineyard in 1989. His Pinot and Chardonnay vineyard also supplies fruit to Tor, Staglin and Knights Bridge. Attention to low yields and meticulous farming produce top-quality fruit. Stomping Girl's dedicated rows are comprised of Calera, Pommard and 777 clones.

Growing Season: Moderate, even ideal, weather throughout the 2012 growing season led to well balanced, high quality fruit. Overall an excellent harvest and vintage.

Tasting Notes: This Pinot Noir exhibits classic varietal tones of red fruit and spice with a hint of forest floor aromatics. Medium bodied with vibrant acidity and soft tannins—an excellent and versatile food wine.
