2012 LAUTERBACH HILL – RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY – PINOT NOIR

Vineyard: Lauterbach Hill Vineyard is owned by boutique grower and producer Stew Lauterbach. Stew's Pinot and Syrah hillside vineyard, just off River and Olivet Road behind Martinelli Winery, is meticulously farmed by Lee Martinelli Jr. Sustainable growing practices are a priority as evident by the birds of prey calling boxes and owl boxes scattered throughout the vineyard. Stomping Girl's dedicated rows are comprised of Pommard and Dijon clones.

Growing Season: Moderate, even ideal, weather throughout the 2012 growing season led to balanced, high quality fruit. Overall an excellent harvest and vintage.

Tasting Notes: An elegant wine imparting hints of candied violets and deep red fruit followed by soft sandlewood notes and a lingering, silky smooth finish.
